## SUSTAINING TENANCIES FACTSHEET

#### WHAT IS SUSTAINING TENANCIES?

Sustaining Tenancies is the Ministry of Housing and Urban Development's main homelessness prevention service.

It funds community-based providers to support individuals and whānau who need help to sustain their tenancy and address issues putting their tenancy at risk.

#### WHO IS SUSTAINING TENANCIES FOR?

Sustaining Tenancies is for tenants in private rentals or public housing who need practical support to help to sustain their tenancy and address any issues that are putting their tenancy at risk. It is for individuals, families and whānau requiring different levels of service including:

- tenants who need a low level of support to stay in their home
- tenants with complex life events and risk factors (may have problems with alcohol and drugs or require mental health support)
- vulnerable tenants experiencing multiple risk factors and adverse life events (may have been recently released from prison or have a history of family violence).

#### SUSTAINING TENANCIES PROGRAMMES IN NEW ZEALAND

In 2017 Sustaining Tenancies started as a trial to support 940 people in Auckland, Wellington and Christchurch who were at risk of losing their tenancy in public housing. The Ministry of Housing and Urban Development added 650 places from October 2019 to June 2020.

As part of the Aotearoa/New Zealand Homelessness Action Plan, Ministers approved the redesign and expansion of the Sustaining Tenancies programme to provide an additional 1,550 places per year for three years to June 2023.

Community-based providers around the country started delivering the redesigned Sustaining Tenancies around the country from July 2020.

#### **HOW DOES SUSTAINING TENANCIES SUPPORT TENANTS?**

Agencies or community organisations can refer tenants to a programme – or tenants can self-refer.

Providers carry out an assessment to find out the type and level of services the tenant needs. They will work with the tenant to develop a whānau-led plan then provide services to the individual, family or whānau based on their plan and the level of support they need.

Providers will deliver core services including life skills coaching, advocacy and support to navigate services, referral to budgeting advice and advocacy with landlords.

Where tenants need additional support, providers will refer them to specialist social and health services.

When tenants have finished their programme the provider will work with them to develop an exit plan.

### REFERRAL TO SUSTAINING TENANCIES PROGRAMMES

Whānau may self-refer to Sustaining Tenancies providers.

Service providers also develop their own referral pathways. These could include:

- Government departments and agencies
- public and private landlords and tenancy services
- local Māori organisations and Iwi
- local GP's and health navigators
- local community organisations
