Zoom became the preferred video conferencing service during the global COVID-19 pandemic and is used by many businesses, health providers, and individuals.

From business meetings, health consultations and just keeping in touch with friends and family, Zoom is an easy to use teleconferencing, webinar, and chat software that has a free option and a paid version.

You can access your Zoom account from the website, download the Zoom Client on to your laptop/computer, or download the Apple or GooglePlay app on to your handheld device.

- Use it for free (some limitations on time apply)
- Use it on your handheld devices by downloading the app from the Apple Store or GooglePlay
- Schedule meetings in advance
- Share your screen
- and much, much more
